How to Use Guide –

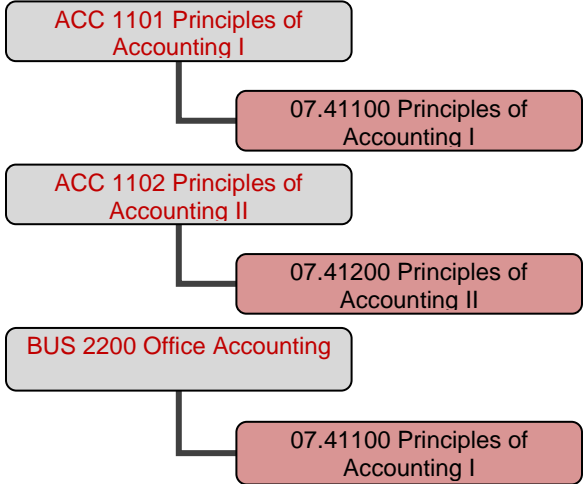
1. determine if needed courses have been taken in High School

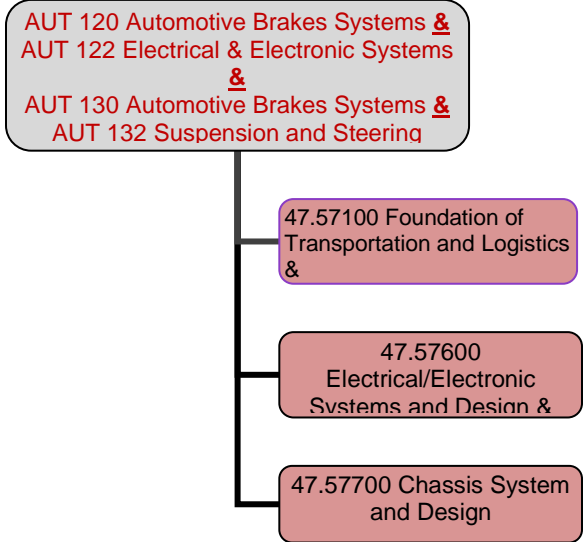

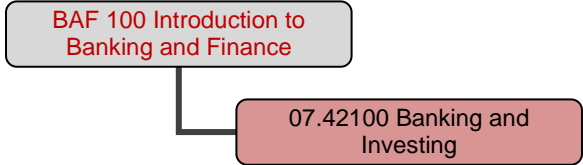

3. Student must complete and pass Sp.2 and Automotive Safety Test

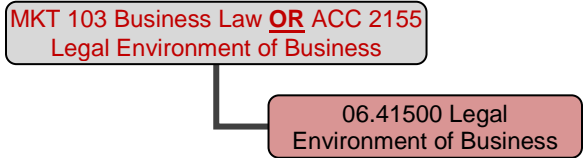
