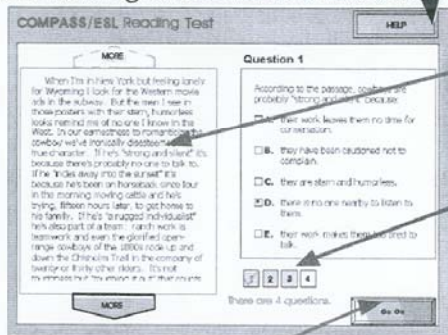


READING COMPASS EXIT TEST INSTRUCTIONS

The Reading COMPASS test involves reading a passage and answering a series of questions on that passage. Reading selections may come from the areas of social sciences, humanities, natural sciences, or general interest.

- Read the directions for navigating carefully before beginning the test.
- To advance to the next question, use the number buttons at the bottom of your screen. Do not click "Go On" until you have completed **all** the questions on the screen (see figure below).

You may not **Go On** until you have answered **all** the questions for a reading passage.

In the reading test the number of questions you must answer for each passage is indicated by numbered boxes below the question field. You may review each question prior to reading the passage by clicking on each numbered box. The question and five answer choices will pop up in the question and answer field to the right of the passage. The box below will turn yellow indicating you are working on this numbered question. Once you have read the passage and are ready to answer the questions, click on a numbered box and the question will *again* pop up in the question field. Click in the small square next to your answer choice and the numbered box below which represents that question will show a green checkmark . Click on each box and answer the question. When there is a green checkmark in all of the boxes, click the GO ON button.
