Get to Know GALILEO Scholar

On March 17, 2008, the GALILEO virtual library system of Georgia changed its interface. You still have access to thousands of online journals, encyclopedias, eBooks, and research databases, but there are now five different interfaces you can search the GALILEO system with. Each interface is designed for a specific audience – academic libraries, public libraries, high school, teens (grades 6-8), and kids (grades K-5).

[GALILEO Scholar](#) is the new look for academic libraries. Among the new features is a better arrangement of databases by subject, a way to search databases according to the type of information they contain and a much easier way to find and search specific full-text journals or magazines.
